#### Marcin Barczyński, Krakow

Prof. Marcin Barczyński is a specialist in general and oncological surgery, with a European sub-specialisation in endocrine surgery. Dr. Barczyński is a doctor with many years of professional experience. He was authorised to practice medicine in 1996 as a graduate of the Faculty of Medicine of the Jagiellonian University Medical College together with a diploma and the title of doctor of medicine. He completed his first degree specialization in general surgery in 1999, in the same year he also received the title of doctor of medical sciences. In 2004 he became a specialist in general surgery, in 2006 he received the title of Fellow of the European Board of Surgery - Endocrine Surgery, in 2011 he was habilitated, and a year later he completed specialization in oncological surgery at the Oncology Centre – Maria Skłodowska-Curie Institute, Branch in Kraków. In 2016, Dr. Barczyński was honored with a title of professor of medical sciences. He is currently Professor of Surgery at the Department of Endocrine Surgery, Third Chair of General Surgery, Jagiellonian University Medical College in Kraków and vice-head of the Clinical Ward of General Surgery and Oncology at Narutowicz Memorial Specialistical Municipal Hospital in Kraków.

During the 8th Congress of the European Society of Endocrine Surgeons in Amsterdam on 24-26 May 2018, a committee of several hundred endocrine surgeons decided in a vote to elect Prof. Marcin Barczyński as President of the European Society of Endocrine Surgeons.

Dr. Barczyński is also currently the President of the Polish Club of Endocrine Surgeons and the Head of the Section of Surgery of the Polish Society of Endocrinology.

Prof. Barczyński performs procedures in the field of general, endocrinological and oncological surgery, he is also an ultrasound diagnostician. The procedures are performed by classical and minimally invasive surgery methods, including videoscopic and laparoscopic surgery.

Dr. Barczyński research interests are focused on endocrine surgery and surgical oncology. He co-authored over 140 peer-reviewed publications in medical journals and 12 book chapters. His citation index is 2016 (according to Web of Science – Core Collection) and H-index is 26.
